Privacy Notice – Surgery Connect (X-On)

As part of the Modern General Practice programme of work, GP Practices are required to adopt a cloud-based telephony system, that has;

- Clinical System Integration,
- · Remote Access.
- Call Reporting,
- · Call Recording and
- Video Consultation capabilities.

The aim of the Surgery Connect platform is to improve communications between healthcare staff and patients resulting in improved outcomes and productivity. The platform facilitates Audio and Video communications between the practice and our patients.

Using the Surgery Connect platform will require the processing of special category data by Accurx, their sub-processors and by default the GP Practice as a Controller. This will include Audio (and Video where applicable).

All Audio calls, both incoming and outgoing will be recorded.

Video will not be recorded without patient consent. There is optional recording of video sessions, or audio part only. Patient can both opt out of, and suspend Video recording.

Surgery Connect is approved by NHS England to be used by GP practices and the other systems involved in patient care. NHS England has a lengthy assurance process to make sure they meet the highest standards of safety and security.
